Fundraising:

- Spirit Wear: Maureen Lynch
 - Sold about 95 pieces of spirit wear.
 - Haven't been delivered yet. Hoping to have prior to Friday for homecoming/spirit day.
 - More people used paper forms than the online form.
 - Short turnaround time for this sale and figuring out how to create a form to take payments for the first time—there were issues getting the form going.
 - Online order form site address was not on the paper form and pushed mainly on facebook it should be advertised better.
 - Jen &Dunbar and Christie Leffakis joining Maureen for a Kerr clothing committee and to get a winter sale going.
 - Less options on this sale than previous ones brought in more sales.
- KidStuff: Windy Neff
 - A few books and sales are still trickling in a week and half past the due date
 - As of today we have sold over 120 books and profited over \$1,500.
 - Still 60 books out that need to be tracked down.
 - Needs to have a person dedicated just to good stuff books next year—a lot of work for a board member.
 - We will most likely do this again on our two year cycle due to the money it generates
- Dine & Donate: Windy Neff
 - Had our first at Chipotle on Monday and we made \$419.95
 - Dine & Donate is a great easy fundraiser for us and we have decided to expand it to every month except for January.
