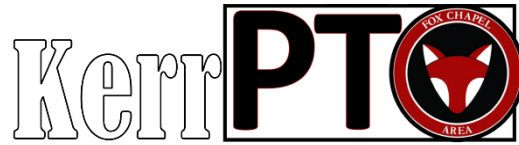


Kerr PTO General Meeting
