March 7, 2018



Welcome: Windy Neff

- Thanks for coming. February meeting kept getting snowed out—so no meeting.
- Flyers left over from story hour—feel free to pick up or wait because they will come home closer to the dates.

School News: Dr. Noro

- Check the newsletter for things happening.
- Parent question about school security in light of recent events. Dr. Noro said that Kerr has done lockdown drills in the past and continue to do it.
 - New building—looking at things like upgrading video cameras. Dr. Noro being ALICE trained with the other principals who weren't trained. Looking over all procedures for security.

Budget: Rob Wilson

- All of the ASK teachers and reimbursements are being sent out. Check for the Summer Send Off for Bounce House going out—all in the program but doesn't come out until check is cashed. Math Pentathlon is coming out.
- Just \$500 short of the entire year's budget fundraising goal.
- Created an online field trip form—teachers can send in the information for the field trip so the PTO can plan ahead.
- Each year the 5th grade students in the safety patrol get a party and due to ownership changes in the location of where they are going, the amount is coming in \$150 above what is budgeted. Need a motion to amend the budget.
 - Breanna Mack motions to raise the budgeted amount to \$650 (from \$500) and Pam Seifried 2nd the motion. Passed with no opposition.

Fundraising: Windy Neff

- Originally the board had decided not to do the Pittsburgh Popcorn Fundraiser because there was no chair for it. Jen Dunbar stepped up to run it. Popcorn profit will be \$672.50. Jen is calling tomorrow to double checking to see when she can pick it up—will announce on facebook if there's a need for sorters.
- Dine and Donate: \$112.69 Wildwood Highlands (check was returned—need to follow up to see if we can still get the money) Reminder to always announce you're there for the KerrPTO—may have been part of the reason the amount was so low. Panda Express had an online glitch the night of our fundraiser, so cooperate gave us credit for all of the online orders during our time.
- Dine and Donate coming up we have Panera and Dunkin' Donuts.
- Reminders for Shoparoo and Box Tops –easy money. Shoparoo should get min \$100 and we have over \$1000 for Box Tops this school year.
- Spirit Wear: joint with Hartwood next fall to assist with meeting minimum sales to get better products.

- NOTE ON ELECTRONIC VOTE: Due to the 2 February meetings being cancelled due to weather, we did an electronic vote, per our bylaws, as we needed to elect a nominating committee, per our bylaws. The vote went out for about 1 week and was 22-0 passed. Pam Seifried, Roseanne LeDonne and Christie Leffakis are the committee.
- Pam Seifried made an announcement regarding the parent involvement around the middle school proposed schedule changes and encouraged people to get informed and involved.

Kerr Garden: Pam Seifried

• Boy Scout Pack 81 is helping take down the garden outside of Kerr. The pack wants to take out plants that can be transplanted to move them to other local parks. Dr. Noro has requested a couple week notice as to when it will be bulldozed over and other items need to be removed from the site.

5th Grade Committee: Pam Seifried

• 5th graders does Penny Wars each year. They raised \$423.38 this year. They would like to combine with money from last year (currently in the form of gift cards) and put towards recess equipment.

Used Book Sale: Windy Neff (read report from Stacy Graham)

• Over 1,000 books donated from students. 1,352 books sold and over 250 books also given away during the sale. PTO made \$338.
