- Any questions about Spanish Immersion Ms. Albrecht is the IA and fluent in Spanish. She is a great addition to the classroom
- Pre K Mrs. Wygant is fantastic and the program is going well
- Building slowly into the school methodically trying to build things up, bulletin boards are coming, tack strips are coming to start hanging artwork, student work, photos are now hanging in the hallways and more will be added shortly

  - Asked for interest in the position and stated that splitting the position is a possibility if 2
    people willing to work together.
  - Short term plan if no interested by 11/15 Secretary Gwen Harcar would take over quickbook entries and check reimbursements and VP DeeDee Malloy would also go on the bank account.
- VOTE NEEDED. For the board to appoint someone per the KerrPTO bylaws to finish out the Treasurer Term if able to by 11/15. If unable to find someone to appoint—the Secretary and Vice President will be added to the bank account and split Treasurer responsibilities amongst the board members.

- Audit Update: We are behind on audits 2017-18 and 2018-19 audits not completed and they need completed in order to maintain status as booster for the school, our 501c3, and also transparency and accountability to our members.
  - o Beth Daniels is willing to Chair Special Committee to complete the audits
  - o New treasurer will assist with this year's audit, entry, and tracking
- Reviewing Budget Report Handed Out:
  - Box Tops number will be low company is transitioning over to be an app now still accepting box tops and dimes – Lindsay McCloskey is heading the chair.
  - Shoparoo should be sending \$246.70 check any day
  - Reviewed the Scholastic Book Fair numbers
  - Teacher Member Reimbursement fund is being used more than in previous years. Most likely due to the mold last year and move to the new building this year. We will make a motion at a future meeting to increase that budgeted amount if needed.
